#### **Tuition and Fees**

Columbia University automatically charges a number of fees for Visiting Students (all CPRL students who otherwise are enrolled at another university): Health Services Fee, University Services and Support Fee, and Student Activities Fee. In prior years, those fees have totaled approximately \$1,400, though they change year to year (see below for 2024-25 costs). **Pursuant to our arrangement with your home school, you are not responsible for the cost of these fees**. Students must provide sufficient information regarding their alternate health insurance plan to allow independent verification that the alternate plan meets the University requirements.
