Eligibility

Students interested in applying to CPRL should consult their academic advisor before applying to the course.

Tuition and Fees

Students do not pay extra tuition to participate in the program; students continue to pay tuition to Columbia. QMSS students can apply for the CPRL Scholar Award via the application by the application deadline.

Credit Breakdown & Grading

QMSS students cross-register for CPRL at CLS. The 13 credits come from three courses: Seminar, Skills, and Project which means that GSAS students who need to be full-time, should register for one more course that semester. The GSAS rules state that the minimum courses needed for full-time status is four (credits don't matter for this). If students are registering part-time, then they don't need to take an additional course to CPRL.
